CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

A. Background of Studies

Someone adopting bad into the spotlight for his neighbour, for example: breaking the norms in force late in life, fraught with deplorable traits, not implementing the obligations which should be carried out objectively, so that this causes damage to the arrangement of environmental systems.²

As for the word morals comes from the Arabic, or "khuluqun" meaning is manners. The word "morals"

As well as in the Greek term "morals" used the term ethos or ethics (without wearing the letter H) the meaning of "contain" ethic is human effort to put the thoughts and the power of his mind to solve the problem of how he should live if they want to be good, and ethics is a science is not a teaching. Boarding school in technical discourse is a place in habited by the students. This statement indicates its significance traits boarding school as an educational
