

## ABSTRACT THE EFFECT OF ASEAN TOURISM FORUM ON TOURISM DEVELOPMENT BY IMPLEMENTING BLUE ECONOMY IN INDONESIA

This research aims to analyze the effect of ASEAN Tourism Forum (ATF) on tourism development by implementing Blue Economy in Indonesia to support sustainable economic growth. This research uses a systematic review with a qualitative research method literatur review based on journals, reports, websites, and books to analyze the impact of ATF for increasing maritime tourism sector in Indonesia. Regarding to ATF as a regional platform playing signific role to facilitate the development of sustainable tourism by ASEAN Tourism Strategic Plan (ATSP) 2016-2025. ATF contributes to enhance the competitiveness of Indonesia's maritime tourism through several initiatives such as promoting natural marine destinations, improving human resources, and strengthening marine conservation regulations. Author identified challenges the implementing Blue Economy for Indonesia's maritime tourism, such as infrastructure development, the availability of trained human resources, and competition from other ASEAN countries. Therefore, a targeted strategy is needed through close collaboration among stakeholders.

Tujuan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk menganalisis pengaruh ASEAN Tourism Forum (ATF) terhadap pengembangan pariwisata melalui implementasi Blue Economy di Indonesia dalam mendukung pertumbuhan ekonomi yang berkelanjutan. Penelitian ini menggunakan tinjauan sistematis dengan metode penelitian kualitatif yang bersumber dari penelitian-penelitian terdahulu seperti jurnal, laporan, website, dan buku untuk menganalisis secara mendalam mengenai dampak ATF terhadap peningkatan sektor pariwisata maritim di Indonesia. Hal ini dibuktikan dengan ATF sebagai platform kolaborasi regional yang berperan dalam memfasilitasi pengembangan pariwisata berkelanjutan melalui kebijakan ASEAN Tourism Strategic Plan (ATSP) 2016-2025. Dalam penelitian ini, ATF berkontribusi dalam meningkatkan daya saing pariwisata maritim Indonesia melalui beberapa inisiatif seperti mempromosikan destinasi wisata alam laut, meningkatkan sumber daya manusia, dan memperkuat peraturan konservasi laut. Para peneliti juga mengidentifikasi tantangan dalam implementasi Ekonomi Biru untuk pariwisata maritim Indonesia, seperti pembangunan infrastruktur, terbatasnya ketersediaan sumber daya manusia yang terlatih, dan persaingan dengan negara ASEAN lainnya. Oleh karena itu, diperlukan strategi yang tepat sasaran melalui kolaborasi yang erat di antara para pemangku kepentingan.


