#### **CHAPTER I**

#### INTRODUCTION

## A. The Background of the Study

Speech acts are utterances produced by humans. When they communicate, they utter words and grammatical construction to accomplish specific tasks when they communicate. A speech act is an important concept in pragmatics that refers to the actions performed by a speaker through their utterances. Their utterance words have certain consequences on the listener and convey their intentions. speech acts encompass a variety of forms, including requests, warnings, promises, apologies, greetings, and declarations. Essentially, speech act theory examines the function of utterances in relation to the attitudes and behaviors of those involved in communication. It consider both the speaker's intention and the impact of their speech on the audience.<sup>1</sup>

The concept of speech acts was notably advanced, Locutionary, illocutionary and perlocutionary. A locutionary act is one in which the speaker's words convey the speech's meaning. The perlocutionary act is the effects that an utterance has on the listener, such as convincing, persuading, or surprising them. An Illocutionary act is a type that reflects the speaker's intention behind the utterance. that perform specific actions in expressing a message. These acts carry a commitment or obligation for the speaker to perform the action specified in their utterance. The functions of speech acts are conveying information through representatives or assertiveness, influencing actions by directives, committing to future actions by commissive, expressing

emotions by expressive and effecting change by declarative. the type is assertive, a statements that commit the speaker to the truth of what is said, directive, a request or command aimed at getting the listener to do something, commissive, a commitment by the speaker to a future action, expressive, an expression of feelings or emotional states, and declarative, a statements that bring about a change in the external world simply by being uttered.

Da'wah, derived from the Arabic, carries connotations of a call, an invitation, and a sense of urging. Da'wah signifies a call to Allah. Preaching communication, therefore, involves the transmission of information or messages rooted in the Qur'an and Hadith, employing both verbal and nonverbal symbols, with the aim of influencing the attitudes, beliefs, or actions of others. If an efficient preaching communication process is in place, preaching operation can be successful. Effective preaching communication is rooted in sincerity and truthfulness, as emphasized in the Qur'an. This verse instructs believers to invite other to the path of Allah with wisdom and good instruction, ensuring that the message is conveyed with integrity and authenticity.

Communication plays a crucial role in preaching, serving as a fundamental means to convey Islamic values effectively and fluencing the target audience towards adopting Islamic principles. Preachers use preaching communication to help people better comprehend the faith and alter their perspective on life, attitudes, and actions to conform to sharia. Enjoining the good and preventing evil is the fundamental purpose of preaching. Furthermore, according to the Qur'an, Muslims have a must to provide preaching, or guidance, to others to lead them from darkness to light. Therefore, the purpose of preaching is to spread Islam among people and society so that everyone can perceive Islam as a system that has many tools to help humanity achieve happiness in it is

Preaching videos, for example, serve as a medium for conveying messages and information aimed at providing viewers with new insights and knowledge.

This research use Assim Al – Hakeem's Islamic preaching video speech to collect data. Assim bin Luqman Al – Hakeem, commonly known as Assim Al – Hakeem, is a Saudi Arabian scholar who delivers his Islamic preaching in English. He is one of the influential Islamic speakers on an international level, particularly among English – speaking Muslim communities. He is widely known for his lectures on various platforms, such as social media and youtube, focusing on Islamic jurisprudence (fiqh) and practical guidance for daily life according to Islamic teachings. He also delivers lectures through programs such as questions and answers (ASK HUDA), Umdatul Ahkaam, youth talk, mercy to the world, peace TV, and Huda TV. His humorous and friendly approach to preaching allows him to reach all segments of society effectively. Additionally, he has served as an imam and khatib (preacher) at mosques in Jeddah for over 20 years.

Research on speech acts, particularly illocutionary speech acts, has been extensively conducted. For example, Sinaga (2024)<sup>9</sup>, Annahlia (2020)<sup>10</sup>, Hariati (2020)<sup>11</sup>. the focus of his research is illocutionary types and their dominant types with the focus of subject utterances with the final result describing each type and also dominant found.

Other researcher also finds about illocutionary speech act. Sari (2021)<sup>12</sup>, Megasari (2024)<sup>13</sup>, Putri (2024).<sup>14</sup> the focus of their research is the types of illocutionary with the focus of subject utterances found with the final result describing the components and types found.

Another research that discuss about illocutionary speech act are Nisa (2021) <sup>15</sup> and Alam (2023)<sup>16</sup> the focus of their research is the analysis of illocutionary speech acts with more than one object with the final result is to classify illocutionary speech acts.

Based on the literature review, this research examines speech acts within preaching videos. This focus is warranted due to the relative scarcity of in-depth studies on this specific medium. Previous research has predominantly concentrated on speech acts in novels, movies, and other contexts, with limited attention given to preaching videos. Furthermore, existing research on speech acts in preaching videos has often overlooked the speaker's perspective, which this study aims to address.
